



ALASKAN ADVENTURE

Day: 1

Location: ARRIVAL

Description: Welcome to Fairbanks, the state's second-largest city. Your Tour Director is on hand late this afternoon to answer any questions.

Day: 2

Location: FAIRBANKS

Description: Morning sightseeing features highlights of this historic city, a chance to learn about the community's Gold Rush heritage, and visits the Alyeska Pipeline. Board the STERNWHEELER RIVERBOAT Discovery III for a cruise on the Nenana River, and visit a recreated ATHABASCAN INDIAN VILLAGE. Listen as the ship's guides discuss the wildlife, history, geology, and customs of the region.

Day: 3

Location: DENALI NATIONAL PARK

Description: Today we make our way from Fairbanks to DENALI NATIONAL PARK & PRESERVE. Stop in the town of Nenana, where they drove the golden spike in 1923 to signal the completion of the Alaska Railroad. Your afternoon and evening are free to explore on your own. Take advantage of the park service programs, along with optional activities that can be purchased.

Day: 4

Location: A FREE DAY FOR INDEPENDENT ACTIVITIES

Description: A hike along the many wilderness trails might be fun. Also take advantage of several optional outings, including a wildlife tour to seek out grizzly bears, caribou, moose, and Dall sheep; a raft trip down the Nenana River; or a helicopter ride over the park. Your Tour Director will have plenty of suggestions.

Day: 5

Location: ANCHORAGE MUSEUM

Description: Today begins with city sightseeing in Anchorage. Visit the ANCHORAGE MUSEUM to see a quality display of artifacts from Alaska's Native people. The afternoon is free to explore.

Day: 6

Location: ALASKA SEALIFE CENTER

Description: Excursion to Seward. Travel this morning to Seward, "Gateway to Kenai Fjords National Park," on the Seward Highway, a designated National Scenic Byway. Visit the ALASKA SEALIFE CENTER, a research facility offering an up-close encounter with marine wildlife from the Gulf of Alaska. Your afternoon is free to join some optional adventures such as a cruise into Kenai Fjords National Park, where you travel up to the face of a glacier, or visit the kennels of the Seavey family, winners of the Iditarod Races from 2012-2015, and ride behind a dogsled team at Iditaride. If you choose to stay in Seward, enjoy lunch in the charming downtown area and enjoy a scenic walk along the coastal trail. This evening, return to Anchorage.

Day: 7

Location: DEPARTURE

Description: The trip ends today with guests departing on individual schedules. Transfers to Anchorage International Airport are included.
